Mark your calendars for 10 to 14 September 1998 to join your colleagues in Washington, DC, for the 3rd International Meeting of Science Editors. The meeting will focus on the theme "Editing Across Disciplines, Across Boundaries, and Through Time". This is expected to be the largest gathering of people

interested in the scientific-publication process in the world. The 2 prior international meetings were held in 1983 in Philadelphia and in 1989 in Ottawa, Canada.

The 1998 meeting is jointly sponsored by the Council of Biology Editors, the European Association of Science Editors (EASE), and the Association of Earth Science Editors (AESE). Joining as cosponsors are the Society of Scholarly Publishing and several other

organizations. In addition to invited papers, there will be a call for papers. Director-General of the meeting is Fred Spilhaus, executive director of the American Geophysical Union, Washington, DC. Watch for more information in later issues of *CBE Views*.
