

Results of the 1999 CBE Election

The CBE membership has endorsed a name change for the organization and elected 4 new members of the Board of Directors.

Members approved changing the name “Council of Biology Editors” to “Council

of Science Editors”. A total of 285 votes were cast for the name change and 33 against. The name change becomes effective 1 January 2000.
