**Martin Blume** is editor-in-chief of the American Physical Society and senior scientist emeritus at Brookhaven National Laboratory. As editor-in-chief, he oversees the *Physical Review* journals, *Physical Review Letters*, and *Reviews of Modern Physics*. He also has served on the editorial boards of other physics journals and the *Encyclopedia of Applied Physics*. His participation in CSE has included speaking at the 2003 retreat on the role of journals in scientific misconduct.
