Two CSE members will receive awards at the 2004 American Medical Writers Association (AMWA) annual conference, to be held 21-23 October in St Louis.

Cheryl Iverson, of the Scientific Publications Group at the American Medical Association, will be given the John P McGovern Medal. This award will honor Iverson for her contributions to

science editing, including those as chair of the committees that prepared the two most recent editions of the *American Medical Association Manual of Style*.

R Elliott Churchill, of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, will receive the Golden Apple Award. This award recognizes consistently outstanding leadership of AMWA workshops.

Churchill has repeatedly taught the AMWA workshops on microediting and macroediting.
