

Highlights of the CSE Board Meeting

The CSE Board of Directors met on 28 January 2006 in Reston, Virginia. Highlights of the meeting follow.

1. The Board approved the CSE statement on group authorship, which the Editorial Policy Committee prepared. The statement, titled “CSE Recommendations

for Group-Author Articles in Scientific Journals and Bibliometric Databases”, is available on the CSE Web site at www.councilscienceeditors.org/publications/group_authorship.pdf. [The statement also has now appeared in the May-June 2006 issue of *Science Editor*.]

2. The Board agreed to form a Task Force on Communications. The charge to the task force will include establishment of a long-term communication strategy for CSE that includes *Science Editor*, the CSE Web site, and other media to be determined.

3. The 50th anniversary

meeting of CSE will take place on 18–22 May 2007 at the Hilton Austin Hotel in Austin, Texas. Because CSE is approaching this grand milestone, the Board agreed that this is an opportune time to embark on strategic planning and approved the creation of a Task Force on Strategic Vision to direct the process.
