

Highlights of the CSE Board Meeting

The CSE Board of Directors met on 22 May 2007 in Austin, Texas. Highlights of the meeting follow.

1. The Board voted to price North American and international dues the same.
2. The Board affirmed the recent creation of the CSE Task Force on AuthorAID and will be establishing procedures for working with the AuthorAID project.

3. The Board voted to support the principles of the EQUATOR (Enhancing the QUALity and Transparency Of health Research) Network (www.nks.nhs.uk/equator.asp), which seeks to improve health care “by promoting the transparent and accurate reporting of health research”.

4. The Board approved the concept of an online nomination form that will allow CSE members to nominate other members for CSE awards, such as the

Certificate of Appreciation and the Distinguished Service Award. Data collected from online nominations will be forwarded to the Awards Committee for consideration.

5. The Board was informed that 2,029 copies of *Scientific Style and Format*, 7th edition, have been sold through 7 May 2007.
